Motorcyclists Rights Lobbyist Update: Bills

Presented by The Lombardo Group, ABATE Lobbyist

2600 new Proposed Laws were introduced by the February 16th Deadline

Senate Bill 92 Umberg (D - Anaheim) Courts: remote proceedings for criminal cases

This bill would provide that, in a misdemeanor, if the accused agrees, the initial court appearance, arraignment, plea, and all other proceedings, except jury and court trials, may be conducted remotely through the use of technology. This would make it easier to fight excessive and targeted noise and motorcycle tickets. *SUPPORT*

Senate Bill 961 Wiener (D - San Francisco) Vehicles: safety equipment speed limiter

This bill would require certain vehicles, commencing with the 2027 model year, to be equipped with an intelligent speed limiter, as specified, that would limit the speed of the vehicle to 10 miles per hour over the speed limit. The bill would exempt emergency vehicles from this requirement and would authorize the Commissioner of the California Highway Patrol to authorize the disabling of the system on other vehicles based on specified criteria. ***OPPOSE***

Senate Bill 1297 Allen (D - Santa Monica) Speed safety system pilot program

Existing law authorizes, until January 1, 2032, specified cities and the City and County of San Francisco to establish a local speed safety system pilot program, operated in certain types of streets and school zones, to detect speed violations by using an electronic speed safety system, as defined. Pursuant to the pilot program, a designated jurisdiction participating within the pilot program with a population of less than 300,000, as

determined by the United States Census Bureau in the 2020 Census, is authorized to operate no more than 9 speed safety systems.

This bill would instead authorize a designated jurisdiction participating within the pilot program with a population of less than 300,000, as determined, to operate no more than 12 speed safety systems. ***OPPOSE***

Assembly Bill 2392 Soria (D - Merced/Fresno) Vehicles: motorcycle: safety helmet exception

This bill would exempt from this requirement a person who wears a turban or patka as an expression of the person's religious belief and practice when riding on a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, or motorized bicycle. TRACKING

Assembly Bill 3102 Hoover (R - Folsom) Vehicles: motorcycle license

This bill would authorize the operator of a motorcyclist training program described above to issue a certificate of satisfactory completion to a person at least 21 years of age who has opted to complete only the skills testing portion of the training program and has successfully passed the skills test. The bill would require the motorcyclist training program operator to, in a manner prescribed by the Department of Motor Vehicles, note on the certificate that the person has completed only the skills testing portion of the program. The bill would authorize the department to accept a certificate issued pursuant to these provisions from an applicant who is at least 21 years of age in lieu of a driving test for a motorcycle driver's license if the applicant has met the other examination requirements for the license for which the applicant is applying. *SUPPORT*

The Legislature Bill Introduction Deadline ended on February 16th, 2024, they introduced over 2500 New proposed Laws (Bills) bringing the two-year Sessions total to over 5300! We were Successful with the reintroduction of AB 3102 Hoover (R – Folsom) which will allow Unlicensed Motorcycle riders to go to any CMSP location and try to Pass the DMV skills rider test. Much like how you renew registration at AAA, now CMSP sites can do on bike tests, which they are already doing, and this Law will save DMV over 15,000 Appointments. Thus, making it easier for the Consumer/Rider to take the Motorcycle skills test while saving the DMV money during a 73 Billion Dollar Budget deficit!

Without the ink even being dry from the Governor's signature on AB 645 Friedman (D – Glendale) last year, allowing for 5 Cities to do a Pilot program to use Cameras to ticket Drivers another Camera ticket bill has been introduced.

SB 1297 Senator Allen would allow any City of 300,000 to have another Pilot ticketing program of 12 cameras. This would allow most of the rest of the State that did not get in AB 645 Friedman's bill to use Cameras to ticket Us! It's about getting our Money! We are again Opposing this bill. We will need your Phone calls and Emails to help defeat this bill.

Another major Bill by Senator Wiener (D – San Francisco) would add a governor on any vehicle sold in our state which would stop vehicles from going 10 mph over the speed limit, even in cases of emergencies!





Your ABATE P.A.C. will be working this year to ensure that we keep the right to choose which vehicles we can purchase, the right to personally repair your vehicles, to stop speed limiters, to stop speed cameras and to slow the adoption of autonomous vehicles until they can safely detect motorcycles, bike cycles and pedestrians. We will also be working to push anti-profiling legislation and to educate our legislators on what that means.

In order to educate our legislators, it is important to meet with them. But this does not mean you have to travel to Sacramento. March 21 is Spring Recess for legislators. They will be returning to their district offices until April 1. Make appointments during this time and see them in their offices. Talk about the issues affecting motorcycling and all vehicles. Offer to be their motorcycling experts.

Your ABATE P.A.C. organization has developed legislative educational packets. Ask for them, brush up on the contents and hand them out. This is why you are an ABATE of California member, to help support the cause.

A quick shout out to Michael DePiero, Martin Lugo Jr. and Dave Connors for stepping up as ABATE Regional Representatives! Their positions include extra assistance to the Local Presidents in running their Locals and in the promotion and execution of the work of ABATE.

On February 11th, ABATE Local #03 attended the Annual Dave Mann ChopperFest in Ventura. We signed up six new members and one renewal during that event. What a great success! We also discovered that when we asked the age-old question "Have you heard about ABATE?" that many said that they have. This is a great example of the success of ABATE's Public Relations Officer; Kathlean "MamaBear" Pedersen and all of you who have helped get the message out. A special shout out to Martin Lugo Jr. and to Mike Hess for the videos they create and share on social media. Love you guys! Do your part and share, like and comment when you see ABATE posts in your social media feeds.

Also a big thanks to Ed Aranda, President of Local #38 for first place, Rick Robison of Local #20 and Mike Hess of Local #19. They all won the membership drive of 2023, in respective order. At a State level new Membership numbers increased 63% in 2023 from the

previous two years! Let's do this again in 2024.

With the New Year comes a bit of administrative business. Do you have any new Local officers? Please notify the ABATE office or me. Those new officers need to sign ABATE's conflict of interest form. Also make sure that your Local donates to the General Fund, Lobbyist Fund and the PAC fund. Each Local should



be keeping enough seed money in their accounts to fund your events. Everything else should be sent to the ABATE State office and identified by which fund you are contributing to. Also, make sure that you have fund raisers at each Local meeting and Bike Nights.

If you look into the Bailing Wire you will find that ABATE Merchandise is making a comeback. Jeff Bassler is producing and selling drink tumblers. I have one and it works great at keeping my coffee hot! Purchase one or two, you won't regret it. This is all for now. Let's make 2024 an excellent one! Get involved! Share the work load!

Caltrans: Strategic Highway Safety Plan

WHAT IS THE SHSP?

The California Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) is a comprehensive, statewide transportation safety plan which provides a framework for achieving zero fatalities and serious injuries across all travel modes and on all public roads. Started in 2005, the SHSP is updated regularly to ensure continued progress and to meet changing safety needs. Currently, over 580 safety stakeholders from over 230 public and private agencies and organizations work together on this effort under the guidance of the SHSP Executive Leadership and SHSP Steering Committees. The SHSP addresses the 5 Es: Education, Enforcement, Engineering, Emergency Response, and Emerging Technologies. In summer 2020, state transportation leaders recognized a bolder and more focused approach was necessary to combat the rise in fatalities and serious injuries that have occurred on California roadways since 2010. Four new Guiding Principles have been incorporated into the SHSP update process to further improve safety:

- 1. Integrate Equity
- 2. Implement a Safe System Approach
- 3. Double Down on What Works
- 4. Accelerate Advanced Technology

Keep the rubber side down and when called to action please help out. ABATE is YOUR organization. Please support by doing ABATE events.


Hopefully our Polar Bear run March 10th will be fun and successful. We have a nice flyer in this BW issue with the details. Please try to attend.

2023 Membership Report

General Membership

Please review your membership lists monthly, make any changes and updates necessary, and then submit to our Assistant Membership Chairman, Bill McClennen. His email address is wam50@ sbcglobal.net . He will put the changes on the master membership spreadsheet. Near the beginning of each month, Bill sends the Local members lists to Local Presidents. Bill has been a valuable asset to the membership program with his record keeping, as well as adding his valuable insights to getting new members.

Now about the Yearly Membership Raffle. Your Local has been given their requested allotment of raffle tickets for our Yearly Membership Raffle. So go ahead and sell away.

Suggestions for ways to use your raffle tickets ... When you send out a renewal, include a raffle ticket in their renewal packet. This will be your way of rewarding your members for being in the Local. Have raffle tickets available at your meetings. Also, when you sell tickets to the public, have the people who sell tickets make a record of who they sold the tickets to. This helps you contact them for possible membership sign-ups.

Renewals, the lifeline of the organization. Please do whatever it takes to keep your membership intact. It does little good to get new members, if you then don't follow-up on their renewals. You must keep your members informed. It is advisable that you send out an email with the minutes from your meetings, especially to those members who were not in attendance. This should help you keep your membership intact.

Get all your members on the computer with their emails. Put the list in a group. When you send an email through the list, send it as a bcc format. The bcc format allows the email to be sent as an undisclosed recipient, which is sent to each member separately, and prevents a mass-hacking. This can safeguard your members' identity.

Finally, don't forget the Spring Bike Nights, Poker Runs and other motorcycle events. Venues like the Rock Store and Cook's Corner. These are all good ways to meet and get new members.






